Flower and Decoration Policy

To preserve the beauty of Bellevue Memorial Park for all families and visitors, please observe the following rules:

- Each interment site (ground, crypt or niche) is provided with one flower vase. Each family is responsible to maintain their flower vase. Replacement vases are available at cemetery office if original vase is unusable or missing.
- **ALL FLOWERS AND DECORATIONS WILL BE REMOVED ON THE "MOWING DAY" SHOWN BELOW. ALSO, SEE MOWING SCHEDULE SIGN AT CEMETERY ENTRANCE AND COLOR CODED CURBS AROUND EACH SECTION.** Full maps also available in cemetery office.
- Flowers and decorations should be removed only by the owner of the property and/or the cemetery staff.

The following decorations are not permitted and will be immediately removed by cemetery staff:

- Fences and borders of any kind, planter boxes, stones, glass/ceramic items, ornaments, statues and solar lights.
- Anything attached to cemetery trees and/or shrubs.
- Decorations should not infringe on interment sites owned by others.
- Decorative (artificial) Christmas trees are allowed only in the month of December and are subject to the holiday schedule removal policy. Trees must not exceed 4ft in height.
